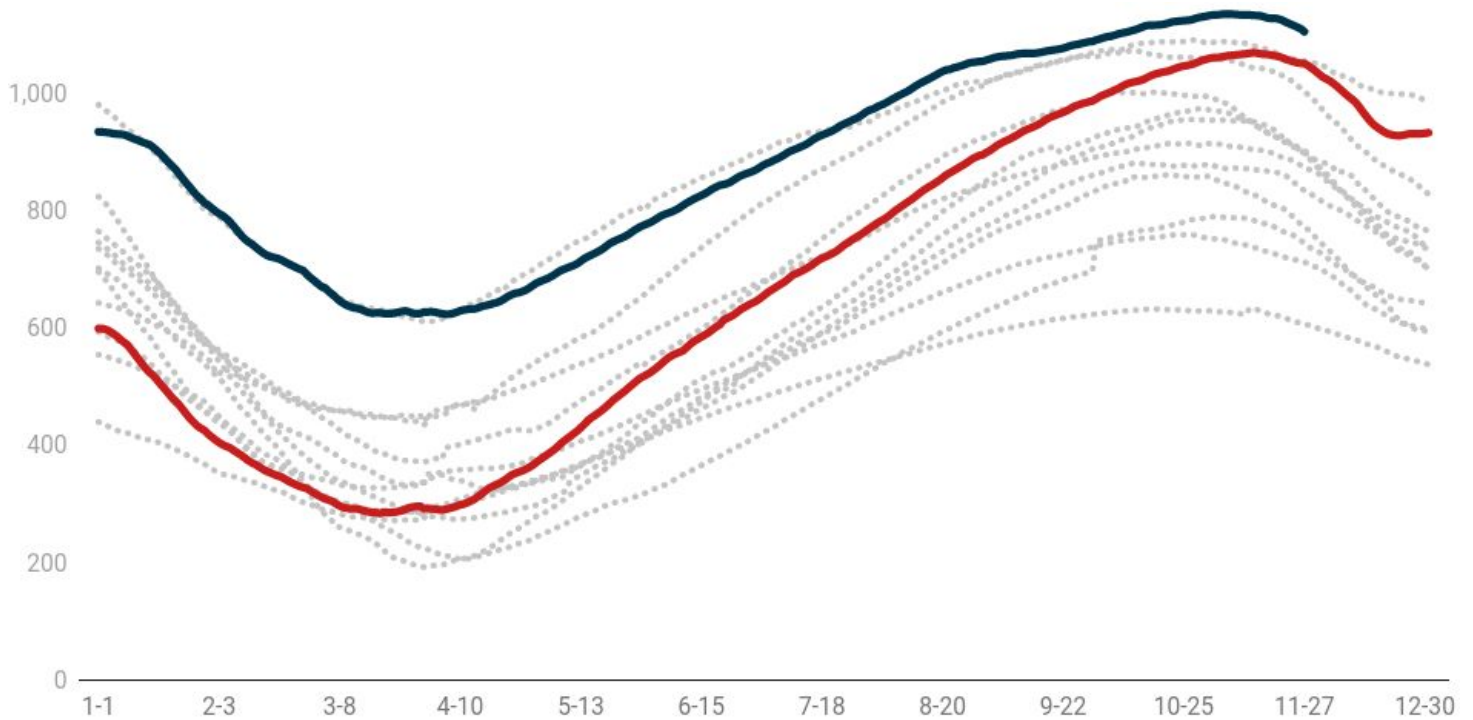
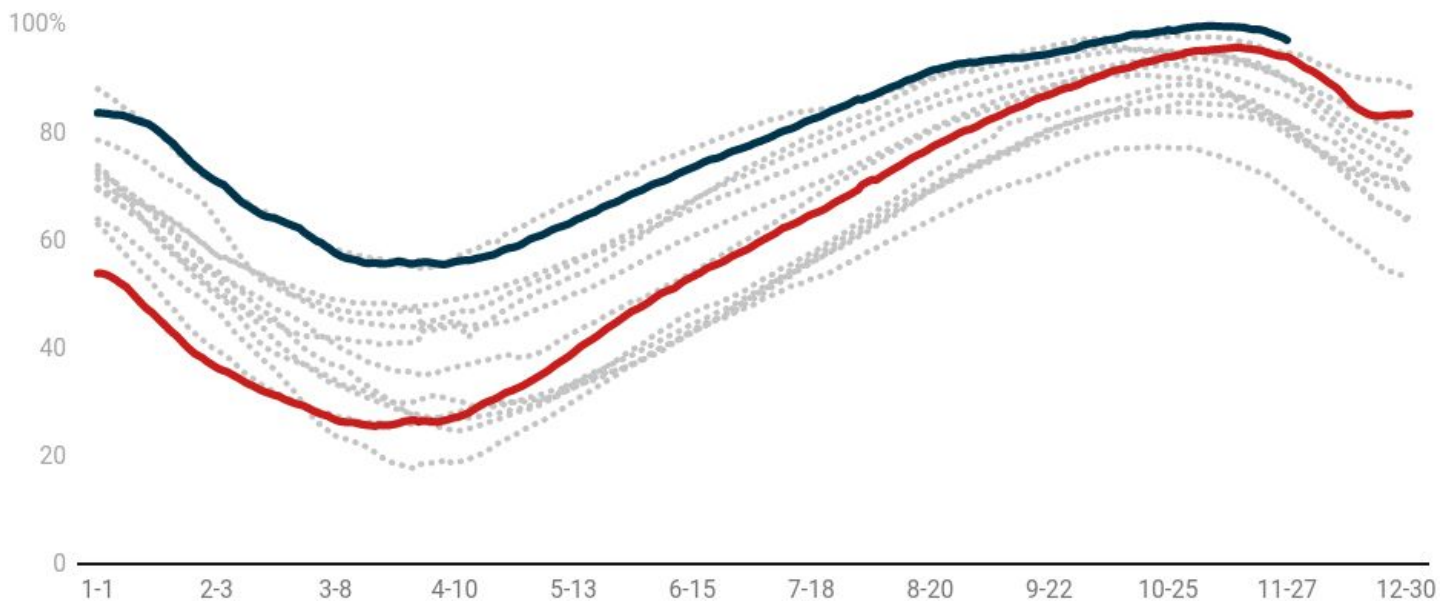

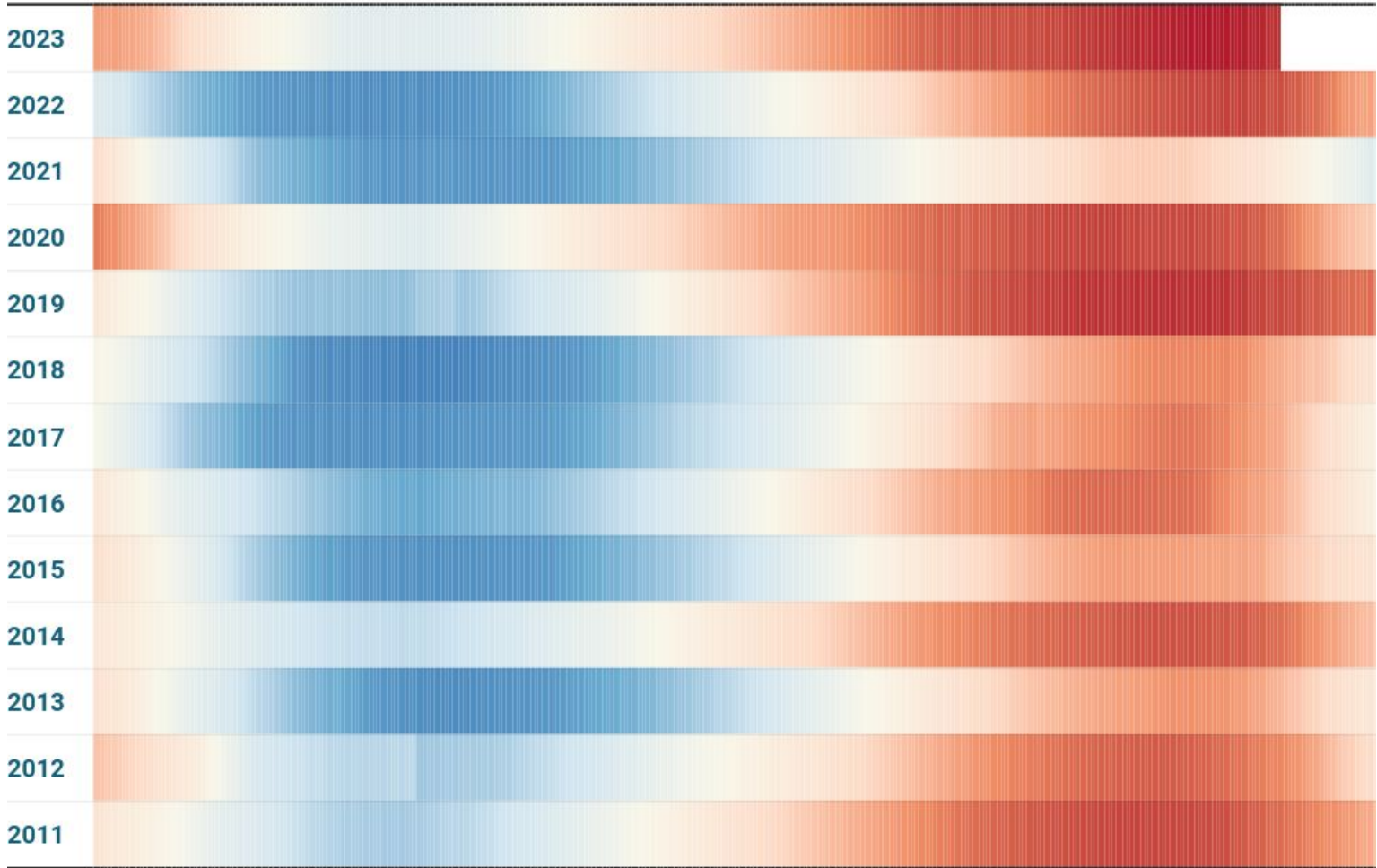
EU Natural Gas Storage (TWh): 1105.6 TWh






















EU Natural Gas Storage % Full: 97.0%



Daily EU Natural Gas Storage Heatmap

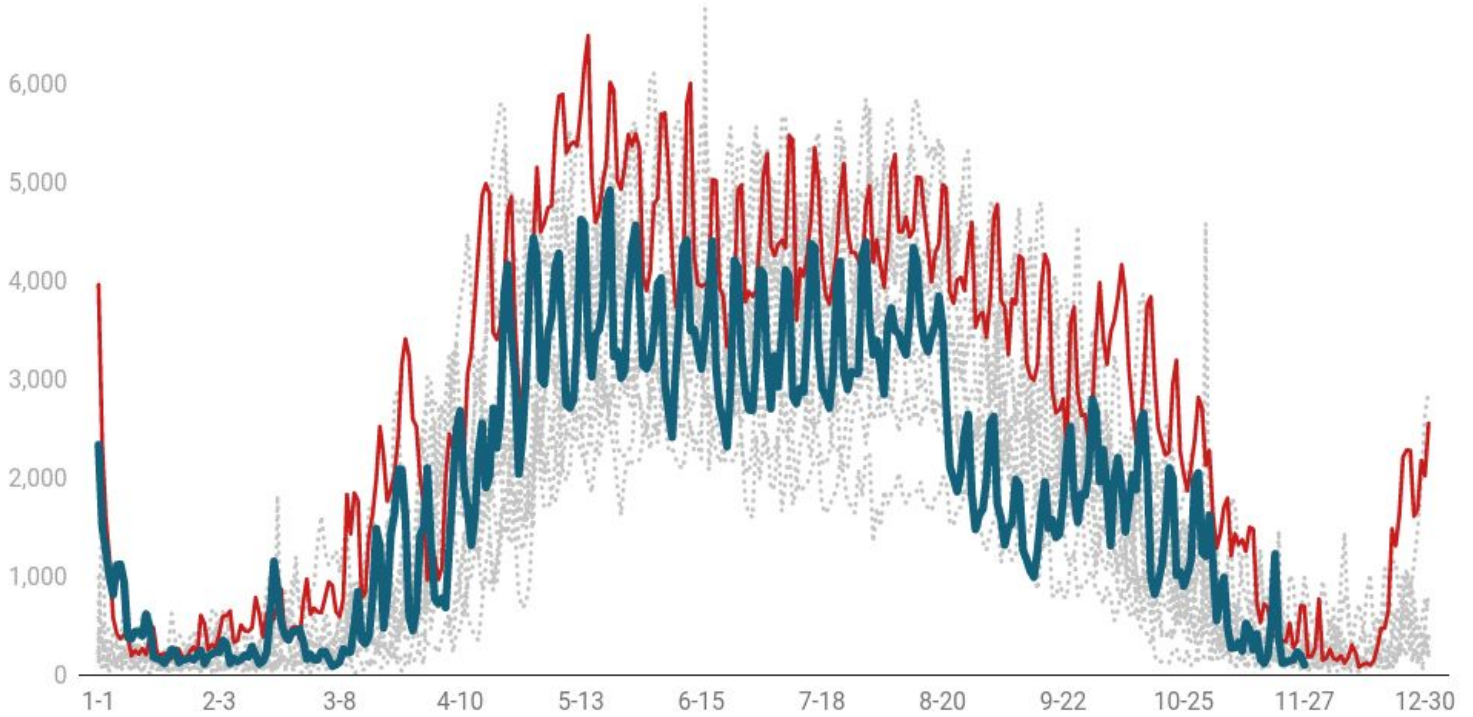

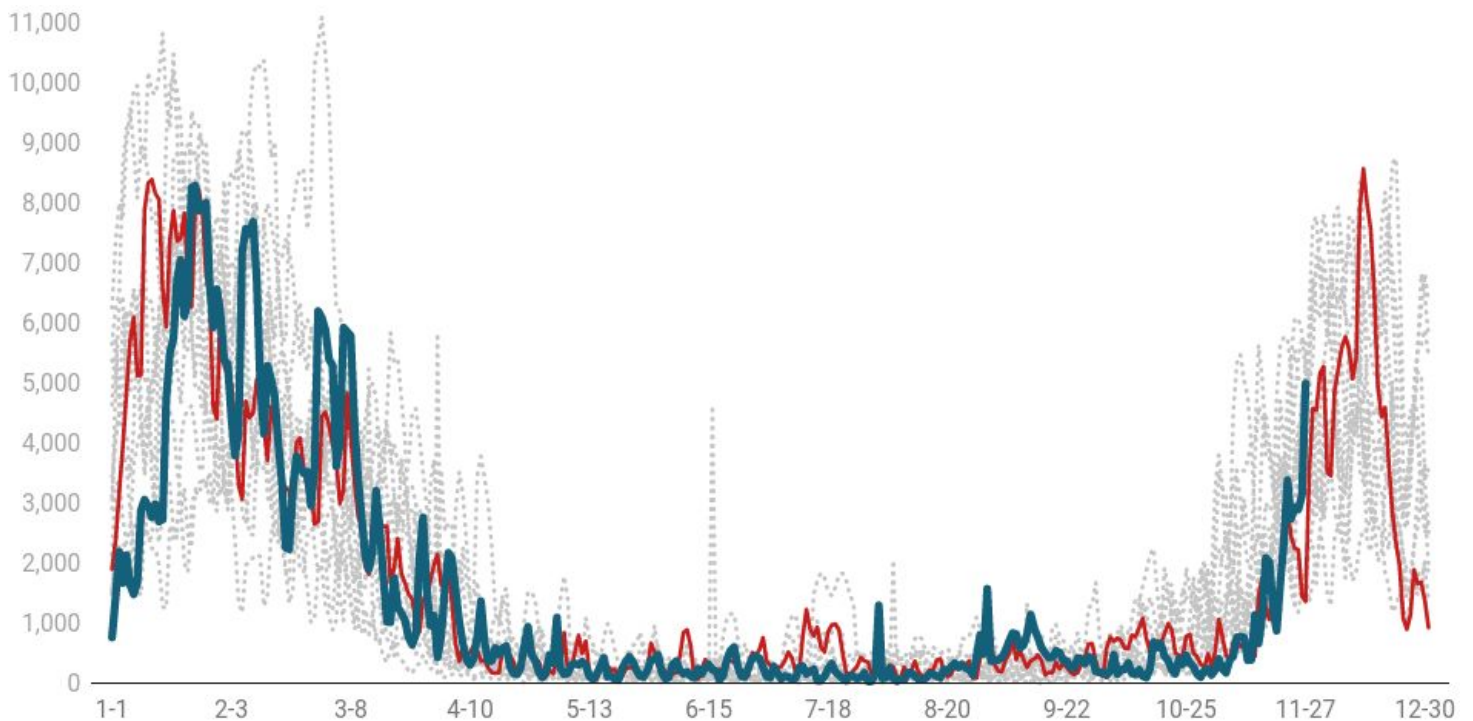
